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Extension Office Hosts Free 4-H Summer Day Camp for Bibb County Youth

The Bibb County Extension Office, in conjunction with many local and regional partners, will host a 4-H Summer Day Camp for Bibb County youth ages 9-18, from 8am-3pm on Tuesday, July 7, Wednesday, July 8, and Thursday, July 9 at Bibb County High School in Centreville.

There is no cost for youth to participate. However, space is limited to 30 youth participants, and all youth who participate must enroll in Alabama 4-H. The registration deadline for the 4-H Summer Day Camp is Wednesday, July 1.

“Programs at this camp will reflect the core values of 4-H and include many different 4-H curricula,” said Charity Battles, 4-H Foundation Agent for Bibb and Shelby counties. “These include Animal & Agricultural Science, Environmental & Outdoor Science, Practical Learning, Business & Citizenship, Creative Arts, and Food & Healthy Living.”

The goals of the Summer Camp are to: 1)improve the visibility of 4-H in Bibb County; 2)involve youth in learning new skills; 3)encourage leadership and citizenship; and 4)provide a positive environment for young people in the communities.

In addition to providing educational programs, the Bibb County Extension 4-H Team of Battles, County Coordinator Matt Hartzell and Administrative Associate Rita Dunn want to see the youth have fun as well.

“If you want youth to participate in a summer activity in a school environment, you need to make it fun, hands-on and experiential for them. We will attempt to do that through field trips to local sites, as well as activities on the campus of Bibb County High School and next to the Cahaba River,” Hartzell said.

Participants will get to practice gardening, rocketry, creative arts, Frisbee golf and recycling. They will also get lunch on each day, a t-shirt, take home projects and invaluable leadership and citizenship experiences.
